B133- Emergency Department, Full-Time, 36-hrs, 7p-7a, weekend/holiday rotations, NE RN License and 1 year RN experience required.

B201- Emergency Department, Full-Time, 36-hrs, 7p-7a, weekend/holiday rotations, NE RN License and 1 year RN experience required.

B197—CCU, On-Call, Variable shifts, Current NE RN License and BLS required. 1 year Med-Surg experience preferred. Will need to take ACLS, PALS, NRP Certifications.

B169—Speech Language Pathologist—(Closes 3/30/10)

Full or Part-Time; M-F, Provides Speech and Language Pathology services including prevention, identification, diagnosis, consultation and the treatment of patients regarding speech language, oral, pharyngeal, and sensorimotor function. Speech Therapy MA or MS Degree, current NE License, CCC or strong CFY may be considered. Valid driver's license and CPR/BLS required.

B168—Sleep Technologist—(Closes 3/30/10)

Full-Time, M-F, 40 hr/wk, Performs all types of sleep disorder testing, including set-up and performance of nocturnal polysomnograms (PSGs) on ages 15 and older. Must demonstrate working knowledge of polysomnography, Multiple Sleep Latency Tests (MSLT), Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP and/or BiPAP®) studies. Scores studies per lab standards once competency is achieved. Graduate of an AMA accredited school of Respiratory Therapy or an accredited RN program. NBRC registration and NE licensure required as a Registered Nurse or Respiratory Therapist. Current BLS Certification. Experience in scoring sleep studies preferred. ONE YEAR EXPERIENCE REQUIRED.

B179—Occupational Therapist—(Closes 3/30/10)

Part-Time, 24 hrs/wk, variable days. Administers evaluations and implements treatment plans and completes documentation for patients requiring O.T. services. Assists with program development for the O.T. department. Bachelor's Degree in O.T. from an accredited/approved program in O.T. Nationally certified or eligible for certification with NBCOT. Must be licensed or eligible for licensure as O.T. with State of NE and current CPR/BLS required.

Performs the daily administrative functions for the department with specific accountabilities to collect process and maintain timely, accurate, and complete patient health information. Fills internal and external service requests for health information. Student may have introduction to other department functions which may include: health record analysis, document imaging, release of information, transcription, abstracting, clinical coding, utilization management, and tumor registry. High School diploma or equivalent required.

Full-Time, M-F, 40 hrs/wk. Must have information Systems experience in the hospital setting, McKesson experience is a plus. Provides technology vision and leadership for developing and implementing technology initiatives. Responsible for department operations and administration.
